Dear parents and carers,

As you will recall, we wrote to you yesterday regarding educational provision for the children of Key Workers as school is closed to the vast majority of children from the end of today. Last night, the government published its list of Key Workers and guidance on this. A link to the document is below:

In summary, the guidance that we are operating to is as follows:

1. If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.
2. If a child needs specialist support, is vulnerable or has a parent who is a critical worker, then educational provision will be available for them.

If you are a Key Worker as detailed on the list attached and you have no way of supervising your child at home, please complete the document and return to school information@tottenhamhighsch.co.uk by midday today (20th March). We will then make provision for your child in school.
